- Recap of the Rally for New West Schools: huge thank you to the families, kids and community members who came out to support us. An enormous thank you to DPAC exec as we pulled this together in about 48 hours! We had three city councilors and the mayor there, plus three school board trustees. Two media outfits also came to interview us, and we did a follow up interview with the Vancouver Sun which made its way into the province. The result of this action: we got the attention of our elected officials in Victoria and the Ministry of Infrastructure has said that Simcoe Elementary is now in their fiscal plan for the year. Our takeaways: this is a win for showing the power of our collective voice, but this is a wholly unacceptable way for critically needed new schools to be moved forward by the ministry.
- **Delegation to Victoria**: On Wed April 9th Laura went with Superintendent Davidson, Board Chair Russell, Board Vice Chair Sluis, P/VP Association president Ken Millard,

NWTU president Kristy Oxley and CUPE president Carrie Andrews to advocate for SD40 regarding our capacity crisis and the critical underfunding of public education as a whole, and for specific areas in our district (child care, StrongStart, employee benefits, portables, life cycle cost analysis of aging infrastructure, climate adaptation and resilience, etc).
